What is an Affiliated Partner?

Since Rhodes does not currently offer any of our own faculty-led semester programs, we send students on semester programs with a number of trusted partners (AIFS, USAC, etc.). Our partner programs are either exchange programs or what we call affiliated programs. As long as you go abroad with an affiliated partner, you are still fully considered a Rhodes student while abroad – and any and all of you Rhodes financial aid will go with you. If the program



includes tuition, room, and board, you pay Rhodes tuition, room, and board and all your aid applies. If the study abroad program only includes tuition, you pay Rhodes tuition. Our affiliated partners also take students on summer programs either to places where we do not have Maymesters, or if a student wants a longer summer abroad experience. Just know that institutional aid is not portable for summer programs, though some federal and/or state aid may be. Talk this over with the Financial Aid office to see if you are eligible to use any noninstitutional aid abroad for the summer.

Spring Around the World

Enjoy Spring Break from the Buckman Center for International Education!

India - Rooted in the Hindu tradition, Holi is a full day and night's worth of celebrating spring. Participants throw colored water and powder at each other, dance, and have bonfires to let go of the bad and embrace the good.



<u>Australia</u> - Every year, Australia celebrates Floriade, a month long festival where you can see millions of flowers in bloom, while live music is playing, as well as art displays and activities to view and take part in.

<u>Bosnia</u> - Bosnians in Zenica celebrate Cimburijada, or the festival of scrambled eggs, at the beginning of the spring season. Residents of Zenica all gather together in the park and picnic as they share the breakfast food they have made with friends and family.



Thailand - Thailand celebrates for three days in April with the Songkran Water festival. This festival signifies the New Year in Thailand and is celebrated with a water fight to cleanse and sprinkling water on other people to show respect and blessing.

<u>Spain</u> - The festival of Fallas is held in Valencia every March and is popular amongst tourists and natives of Spain. The week long festival involves honoring Saint Joseph, incinerates ninots, and participants in the celebration often wear medieval clothing.
